



# Booker T Washington/Robert E Lee/Staunton High School Athletic Hall of Fame

The mission of Staunton High School's Hall of Fame Committee is to recognize and honor the exceptional accomplishments of those historically involved in the athletic program(s) at Staunton High School. Hall of Fame nominees shall include individuals who have enhanced the performance and accomplishments of Staunton High School's athletics through their distinguished athletic achievements, or through their various contributions to Staunton High School's athletics. Nominees should include student-athletes, coaches, or other contributors.

A **STUDENT-ATHLETE** is a former student participant who is being nominated for his or her achievements in high school athletics. To be eligible for nomination, a student-athlete must have graduated from Staunton High School at least 5 years prior. Student-athletes will be considered primarily on their achievements as a high school student-athlete. Such achievements being considered include All-State, State Champion, State Place Winner, State Qualifier, State All-Star, etc. honors. The student-athlete's character and other involvements during and after high school will also be a consideration.

A **COACH** will be considered primarily for his or her achievements while coaching for Staunton High School. The nominee's character and other involvements at both Staunton High School and in the community will also be weighed and receive consideration.

A **CONTRIBUTOR** is an individual who has made outstanding contributions to the interscholastic athletic program(s) at Staunton High School. A nominee will be considered primarily on the merits of his or her contributions and involvements to Staunton High School's athletics.

1. All nominees will be judged on their significant and/or long-term contributions to Staunton High School's athletics. The Hall of Fame Selection Committee may also consider a nominee's total record of contributions to Staunton High School's athletics in determining eligibility for candidacy, and not just his or her record of service in the category in which the nomination is made.
  - a. The Selection Committee also may waive the minimum years of service requirement, or grant special consideration when exceptional circumstances exist such as, but not limited to, injury, illness, or death which would have prevented an otherwise worthy candidate from meeting the requirement.
  - b. Inductees into the Hall of Fame will be considered role models for the student athletes, coaches, the athletic program, and contributors of Staunton High School. As such, the Staunton High School Hall of Fame Committee reserves the right to remove from the Hall of Fame those inductees who have not maintained the same standards required for induction.
2. The nomination and induction process will take place annually.
3. During an induction year, all nominations not selected will remain on file for consideration again during subsequent induction years.
4. The Athletic Director will choose the date and setting for each induction ceremony.
