

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION AT SCHOOL BOARD MEETINGS

Allotted Time for Public Input

A reasonable period of time (Policy BDDH/KD) is defined as permitting each speaker, who has been properly recognized by the Chair, to address the School Board for no longer than two (2) minutes.

Thirty minutes of agenda time will be allotted for public input at each regularly-scheduled monthly meeting.

SCS Student Speakers

Any SCS student wishing to address the School Board during the public input period of any regularly-scheduled monthly meeting should, by the end of the school day on the Friday before the School Board meeting, contact his/her school Principal to indicate a desire to speak at the next meeting. The Principal will work with the Clerk of the Board to register the student to speak at the meeting. Any student who has pre-registered, as indicated above, shall be called upon in advance of the other members of the public in attendance at the meeting who have signed up to address the School Board during the public input period.
