1. **Project Search Overview** Andy King

Began in 2015 at Augusta Health, collaboration with Augusta Health, Career Supports, DARS, and the school divisions of Staunton, Augusta and Waynesboro

Focus is threefold: skills training, interns are immersed in the workplace (hard and soft skills), writing resumes, applying for jobs and follow up support after hire to ensure continued success after hire (Career Supports and DARS)

Project Search is a 1 year program.

1. Graduated from high school (Applied Studies Diploma)
2. 18-22 years
3. Students are enrolled in DARS
4. Students are seeking employment
5. Each student completed 3 different internship experiences throughout the year.
6. Each student leads a Direction/Reflection at the conclusion of each internship

In the five year we have worked with Augusta Health, 4 students have been employed by the hospital. Each graduating class of Project Search has over a 70% employability rate.

Moving forward, we will return to the hospital as soon as we are safely able. Augusta Health remains a steadfast partner. If we cannot start at the hospital, we are planning to start the 2021-22 school year at Dixon Educational Center for center-based and community-based work experiences.
