<p><b><u>Chromebooks 101</u></b></p> <p>What is a Chromebook, and how is it different from a laptop or an iPad? Attend this session to learn about the basics of a Chromebook, how to turn it on, how your child will log-on, and other characteristics which make it a unique learning tool.</p> <p><b>Locations:</b> 6th grade: B-15 7th grade: A-13 8th grade: D-19</p>	<p><b><u>Student Expectations &amp; My Responsibility</u></b></p> <p>You’ve signed for your child to have access to a Chromebook, both at school and at home. What are the school’s expectations, and what will you be responsible for? <p><b><u>Google Classroom</u></b></p> <p>How will having access to a Chromebook change your child’s learning experience? How will your child receive assignments? How can you know what your child is learning?</p> <p><b>Locations:</b> 6th grade: B-1 7th grade: A-8 8th grade: B-25</p>	<p><b><u>No Wi-fi at home?</u></b></p> <p>What if your child doesn’t have access to wi-fi at home? This session will show you how your child can still use the Chromebook to complete school assignments, even without internet access.</p> <p><b>Location:</b> Shelburne Library</p>	<p><b><u>Supporting Your Child in using <i>Read and Write &amp; Learning Ally</i></u></b></p> <p>Read and Write is an application that allows students have access to word prediction software and audio. <p><b><u>Supporting my child in Math</u></b></p> <p>Shelburne students can access IXL and other math websites to continue their math learning outside of school. Come to this session to learn different ways to support your child in learning and extending math at home.</p> <p><b>Locations:</b> 6th grade: B-9 7th grade: A-6 8th grade: D-10</p>	<p><b><u>Supporting my child in Science</u></b></p> <p>All Shelburne students can access their science textbook digitally. Come to this session to learn how your child can log-in to the textbook and use the audio support.</p> <p><b>Locations:</b> 6th grade: B-3 7th grade: A-3 8th grade Sci/Tech: D-22</p>	<p><b><u>Helping Your Student Become a Confident Writer</u></b></p> <p>Come to this session to learn strategies for supporting your student writer at home. Find ways to help your student plan and organize ideas, and then share and collaborate for revisions.
