



Prior to taking the test, students must complete the following:

Students will need to register first at the [DMV site](#)

Complete the following:

- Select Learner's Permit Test
- Select Staunton Public Schools
- Select Staunton High School
- Select the testing day you want to test

2021-2022 Testing Dates are as follows:

- Monday, October 25, 2021
- Monday, November 15, 2021
- Monday, February 21, 2022
- Monday, March 7, 2022
- Monday, April 18, 2022

When registering, do not worry about customer #. You only need to complete the information marked with an asterisk (*). Once you get to the bottom, type in the security code and submit. It will then prompt you to submit again. Then you should see a congratulations screen. If you receive a message that you are not eligible to take the test at Staunton High School, this may be a result of previous attempts. We recommend that you make at least two attempts at registration if the first attempt failed. If you do not receive confirmation of a successful registration, you may need to contact the DMV to set up an appointment to take the test at their locations.

Test Day Information

The tests will start at 2:00 in the STEM Lab with Coach Laase. Students must bring their school issued chromebook or personal technology to take the testing on. Charging stations will be available.

Upon entering SHS, students will wear a mask at all times, similar to classroom expectations.

The test will consist of two sections:

~The first section will be 10 questions on signs. You must go 10 for 10 on the signs. You cannot miss any. If you miss anything, it will end your testing. If you go 10 for 10, it will push you to the next test.

~The second test will be 30 questions on rules and regulations. You can miss up to 6 questions on this portion of the test, but no more than 6.

Each test is similar to online testing. You can skip a question and come back to it at the end of the last question. Nothing will be official until you submit and score your test. The average high school student takes 3 attempts to pass this test. If you do not pass this time, we can set you up again for another testing in 15 days. After 2 attempts, you will have to take the next test at the DMV Site.
