### **Power School Parent Portal – Important News**

**Parent Portal** is available for all students in grades K-12. Sign-up for Parent Portal is **required** for all parents who wish to modify their call system preferences regarding events throughout the year and **schedule changes related to weather**. Parent Portal provides parents access to attendance and grades 1-12 and the portal allows parents to access information about their student's progress from the teacher grade books, including individual assignments, grades, and teacher comments. **Additionally, all parents (grade K-12) can update contact information (phone numbers, addresses, etc.), emergency/medical information, etc. in Parent Portal.** If you do not have your Parent Portal account set up, please contact or stop by your school office for your account set-up information.
