SCS Offering Summer Food Service Program

(STAUNTON, VA – June 17, 2015) Staunton City Schools has partnered with the Piedmont Community Impact Organization, Inc. to participate in the Summer Food Service Program. The Summer Food Service Program offers meals, free of charge, to all children ages 1-18. Children who are part of households that receive government benefits such as food stamps or benefits under the Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservations, or Temporary Assistance to Needy Families are invited to participate in the program to receive free meals.

Meals will be served in the school cafeterias at Ware Elementary School, Shelburne Middle School and Robert E. Lee High School. The program does require that the meals be consumed at the location where they are provided. The dates and times are as follows:

- Ware Elementary School
Monday through Friday – beginning July 7 through August 18
8:30 a.m. – 9:30 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. – 1:00 p.m.
- Shelburne Middle School
Monday through Friday – beginning July 7 through August 18
8:30 a.m. – 9:30 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. – 1:00 p.m.
- Robert E. Lee High School
Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays – June 23 through July 30
7:00 a.m. – 8:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m.
